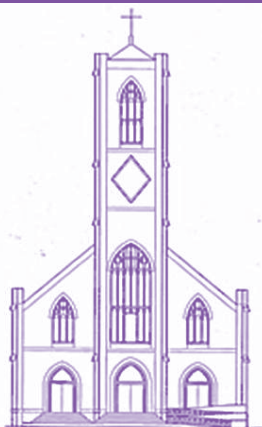

THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION: In order to receive this grace of the sacrament one must acknowledge good and evil in one's life. Thus the setting of the moral standards are needed to practice reconciliation with God, within oneself and with others. It is the most healing sacrament where Jesus gave the Apostles to forgive sins were he said whoever sins you forgive, they will be forgiven... It gives us an overwhelming feeling of God's mercy through the ministry of the Priest. In the sacrament of penance the faithful who confess their sins to a legitimate minister, are sorry for them, and intend to reform themselves obtain from God through the absolution imparted by the same minister forgiveness for the sins they have committed after baptism and, at the same time, are reconciled with the Church which they have wounded by sinning. When I was doing my Masters in family counseling my psychiatric professor said to us that confess is the best Sacrament of healing that the church has in practice of faith. He was a Jewish Rabbi and also a Psychiatric doctor who knew the importance of Christ healing touch in the Sacrament of Penance.

The Reconciliation or confession day will be the Monday of 19th December from 4pm to 8pm. In every parish in the Archdiocese there will be priests available to give the sacrament. So you all are invited to celebrate the healing, and also our CCD and Confirmation group can go to the priest of their choice to celebrate the sacrament.
